The TT Club Supervisor collects the "Collection File" from the Pre-Prep Office at 4.00 pm so that she can check any information recorded in the file about changes to the usual collection arrangements which have been made during the day and add any new arrangements that are made by parents during TT Club (see policy on "Non-Collection of Children").*

It is the policy of the Pre-Prep that all children shake hands with the member of staff they are with immediately prior to being collected to go home with their parents, carers or whoever has been officially designated to collect them. No child must ever leave the classroom without the direct supervision and knowledge of the member of staff who is last with them.
